Food/Drink

We are **gluten free & vegetarian**, but also eat fish/seafood.

Scott is allergic to eggs on their own, but baked into other foods are okay.

When possible, we love to eat local!

We prefer to eat *at least* one hour before the show, or immediately following.

Room temperature water is our drink of choice preceding and during the show!

Sound Check/Load-In

We need approximately 1.5 hours previous to showtime to load-in and sound check.

While we mostly travel with a camper and have our own space, we appreciate a place we can retreat to in order to warm up when possible (we have loud voices, so preferably somewhere folks won't be disturbed).

Transportation

We travel with a truck and a pull-behind 17' camper (Casita). We're great at backing up, and would appreciate a level place to park with adequate space to get situated. If you cannot accommodate this, please give us enough notice that we can make arrangements to drop the camper at a safe location close by- we would appreciate suggestions in doing so.

Lodging

We do travel with our dog(s). We are all happy to stay in our camper overnight, and appreciate access to a shower in the morning.

We are also grateful for indoor accommodations of a simple enclosed bedroom wherein there is adequate space to place a large dog bed (provided by us).

Dog Clause

Our dog, Mud Puddle, has been traveling with us for over 9 years, and often remains on the stage where she is permitted. She has slept through over 700 of our performances over the years, and often folks are unaware she is there until we draw attention to her. If there is not a conflict with food/drink service, allergies, or other pets, and you are comfortable with Puddle's presence, she would love to attend the show. If you are in any way uncomfortable,, she will remain in the camper for the entirety of the performance with no trouble.
